## What is mental illness?

A mental illness is a medical condition that disrupts a person's thinking, feeling, mood, ability to relate to others and daily functioning.

Just as diabetes is a disorder of the pancreas, mental illnesses are medical conditions that often result in a diminished capacity for coping with the ordinary demands of life.

Serious mental illnesses include major depression, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD), panic disorder, posttraumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and borderline personality disorder.

The good news about mental illness is that recovery is possible.

Mental illnesses affects one out of four people worldwide; it affects persons of any age, race, religion or income.

Mental illnesses are not the result of personal weakness, lack of character or poor upbringing.

Mental illnesses are treatable. Most people diagnosed with a serious mental illness can experience relief from their symptoms by actively participating in an individual treatment plan.

## NAMI Basics (signature program)

This is a free six-session course for parents and other primary caregivers of children and adolescents living with mental illness. It offers an overview of the systems involved in caring for children and teens; the biology of mental illness; coping skills and much more.

## FAMILY-TO-FAMILY (signature program)

This <u>free</u> twelve-week program is for families, partners, or friends of a loved one diagnosed with a mental illness. Participants gain insight into schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, depression, PTSD, and other mental disorders. Sessions address self-care, problem solving, communication techniques, and empathy. The biology of the brain, medications, recovery and rehabilitation are also explored.
